(New Orleans, LA April 7, 2020) The Orleans Parish Criminal District Court has extended its closure through April 30, 2020 due to the continued public safety concerns related to the COVID-19 pandemic. Those individuals with pending cases set during this closure, should now report to Court between May 18, 2020 through May 22, 2020 to secure a new court date during the normal hours of operation.

All jury trials are suspended for the duration of this order and All juror service has been suspended through the month of May 2020.

The Court will continue to work closely with the State of Louisiana, City of New Orleans and Louisiana Supreme Court regarding openings and closings.
